Beginning in mid-September 2003 and extending through July 2004, the Graduate School of Education will offer preparation and support for NBPTS candidates through two 3-credit courses. These yearlong seminar courses are intended to provide an extensive professional development experience to teachers who are candidates for certification during the 2003-2004 year. These courses are *Analysis of Professional Practice* and *Critical Issues in Teaching and Learning*, designed and taught by Board Certified Teachers.
